The Taymouth Indians of the Huron Tribe were the first people to inhabit the Vienna Township area. In 1833 Charles McLean came from Saginaw County and became the Township's first settler.

Because of the abundance of pine timber and Brent and Pine Run Creeks the lumbering industry prospered in the area. Then as the land was cleared of trees it became a farming community and a stagecoach stop. Clio is now a suburban community located between Flint and Saginaw; Vienna Township enjoys a combination of open spaces, residential development, small-scale agricultural activity and business development.

### **COOPERATION & SHARED SERVICES**

#### **CLIO AREA FIRE DEPARTMENT**

The first fire department was organized in 1882 and has grown along with the community. In 1976 the Clio Area Fire Authority was formed. It is a joint-operating agreement between the City of Clio and Vienna and Thetford Townships to proved fire protection for the 72-square mile community. Financed by an area-wide one-mill property tax levy or the equivalent, it operates two stations-

- Station One 3291 W. Vienna Road
- Station Two, 11492 N. Center.

The Clio Firemen's Homecoming starts on Wednesday and features a BIG PARADE on the Thursday of that week.

#### **CLIO AREA LIBRARY**

The Genesee County District Library operates a branch library at 2080 West Vienna Road. It is funded by annual contributions from Vienna Township, Thetford Township, and the City of Clio. #### TWO AREA SENIOR CENTERS

#### PARKS AND RECREATION

The Clio Area Parks and Recreation Board, formed in 1989, coordinates recreational activities and grant requests and has successfully received nearly \$1 million in state and federal funds to support recreation. These activities are largely a result of the spirit of the community volunteers and the cooperative efforts of the three municipalities and the school district. Area residents have access to the Art Center, Historical Center, the Clio Bike Path, the Clio Area Youth Sports Complex, the school playgrounds, Clio City Park and Thetford Minipark. Through the Parks and Recreation Board, the Clio area is actively pursuing further development of "walkable Community" for its residents and connecting neighboring communities to Clio.



In 1992 the Charter Township of Vienna formed the Vienna Township Business Development Authority (BDA) to encourage commercial growth in the Township. Water, sewer, and sidewalk infrastructure expanded from the City of Clio along Vienna Road to include Linden Road, creating a business district corridor. New businesses were attracted to Exit 131 along I-75 and today the BDA is proud of a vibrant business district. The

BDA has developed an extraordinary beautification project that began in 2011 to include colorful flower beds along Vienna Road. The BDA has earned awards for beautification and a "best exit award" for manicured lawns and flower garden displays. Additionally, street lighting has created a

warm and inviting exit for the business district with seasonal Christmas decorations and light pole ornaments. The BDA is known for its management of Bridge Park - a beautiful park with a large Monarch Butterfly habitat, Jennings Road Park, the Trolley Line walking trail, Clio Youth Sports Complex, Auto City Speedway, and several unique locally owned stores and restaurants. One of the primary tasks of the BDA is to attract and retain business, as well as help shine a spotlight on the businesses that choose to call the BDA district their home.
